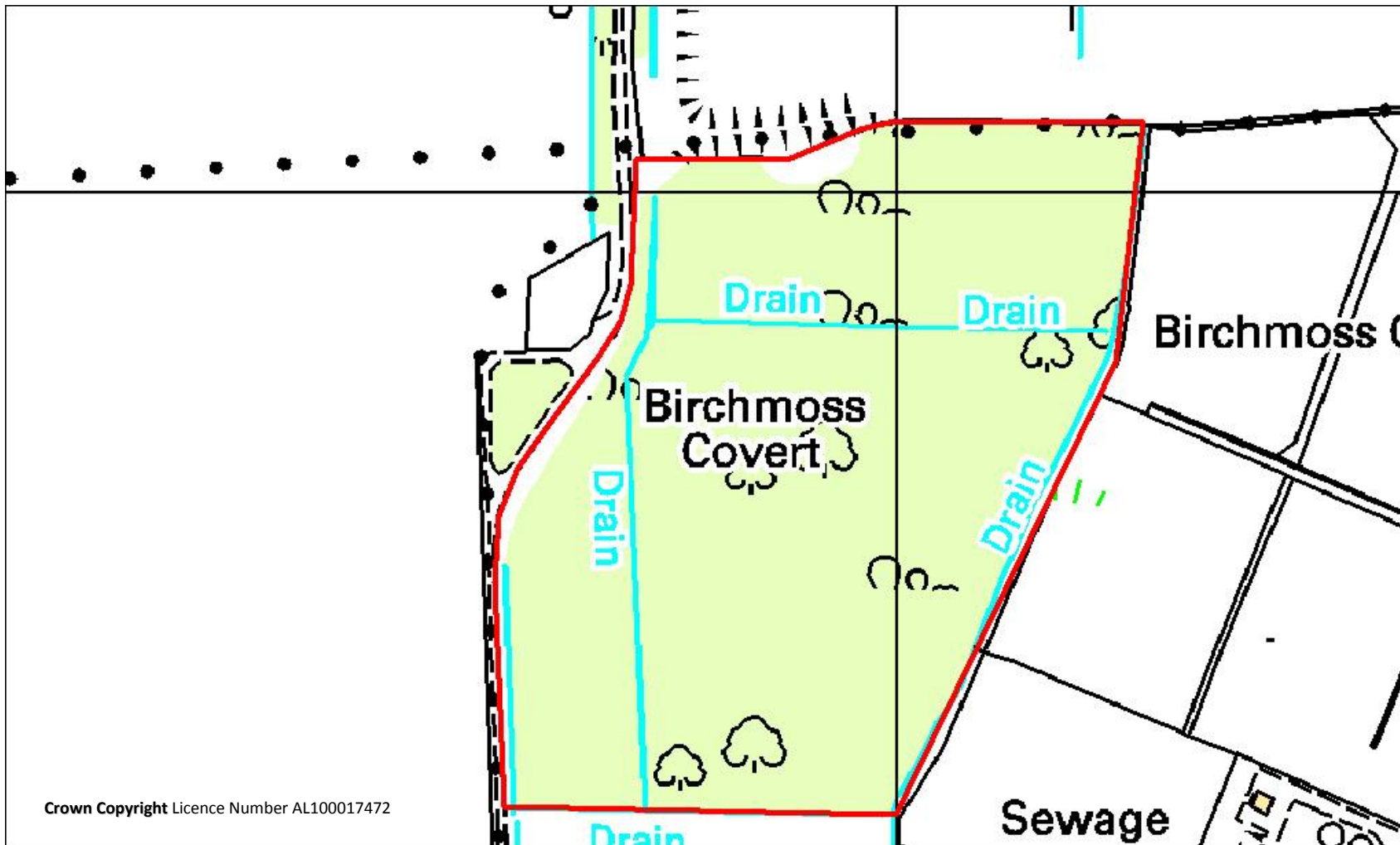


BIRCH MOSS COVERT

Access: Have you got your permit?

Access to this site is restricted. Permits are required, these are obtainable from Cheshire Wildlife Trust; please email Jacki Hulse, Head of Estates & Land Management, on jhulse@cheshirewt.cix.co.uk to apply for one.

Location: Birch Moss Covert lies on Carrington Moss (now mostly reclaimed for agriculture) north of Sinderland Lane which runs off the A56 (Chester Road) at Broadheath and south of the Shell Carrington Works (O.S. Grid Ref: SJ749908).



Habitat Summary

Birch Moss Covert is a 6ha small birch-dominated woodland on relic mossland. Alder and willow occur in the wetter areas. There are several small glades dominated by bracken.
