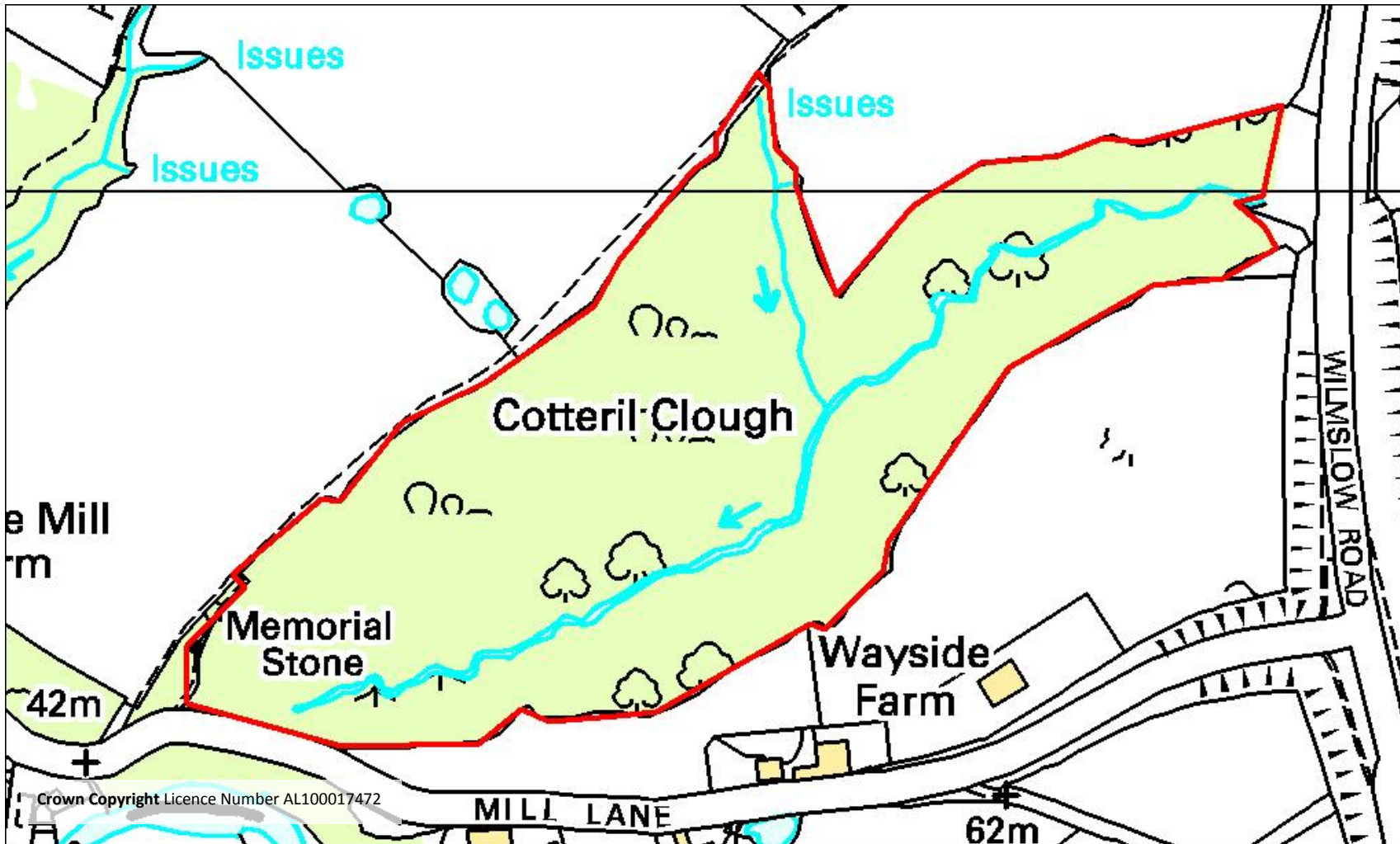


COTTERILL CLOUGH

Location: The reserve lies to the west of Manchester Airport and is situated astride a tributary stream of the River Bollin (O.S. Grid Ref: SJ805839).



Habitat Summary

A SSSI designated ancient semi-natural woodland comprised of ash, oak, alder, wild cherry, hawthorn and elder. Plants of interest include bluebell, lesser celandine, wood anemone, wild garlic and marsh marigold. Birdlife thrives in the clough.
