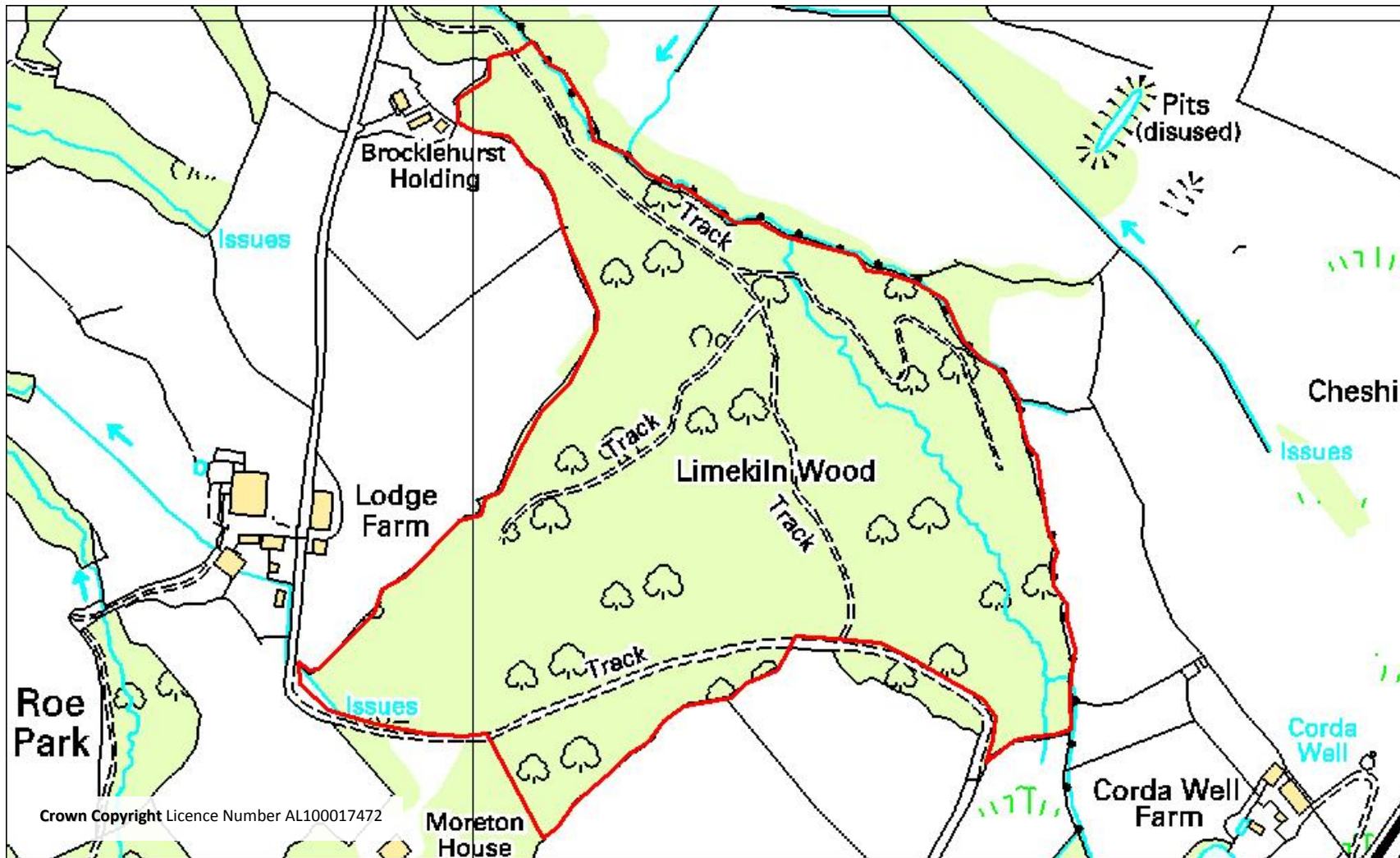


# LIMEKILN WOOD

**Access:** The reserve is open to all. Please keep to the paths, No dogs allowed.

**Location:** Limekiln Wood is near Mow Cop, Congleton (O.S. Grid Ref.: SJ862587). It occupies 13.1 hectares (32.4 acres).



## Habitat Summary

The canopy consists mainly of oak, downy birch and rowan with a dense understorey of holly. Alder occurs where there are wet flushes and along the stream. Many different species of lichen and fungi can be found on this site including foxy spot, stinkhorn, birch polypore and blushing bracket. A variety of caddis fly larvae, mostly case less can be found in the stream along with mayfly and stonefly larvae.
