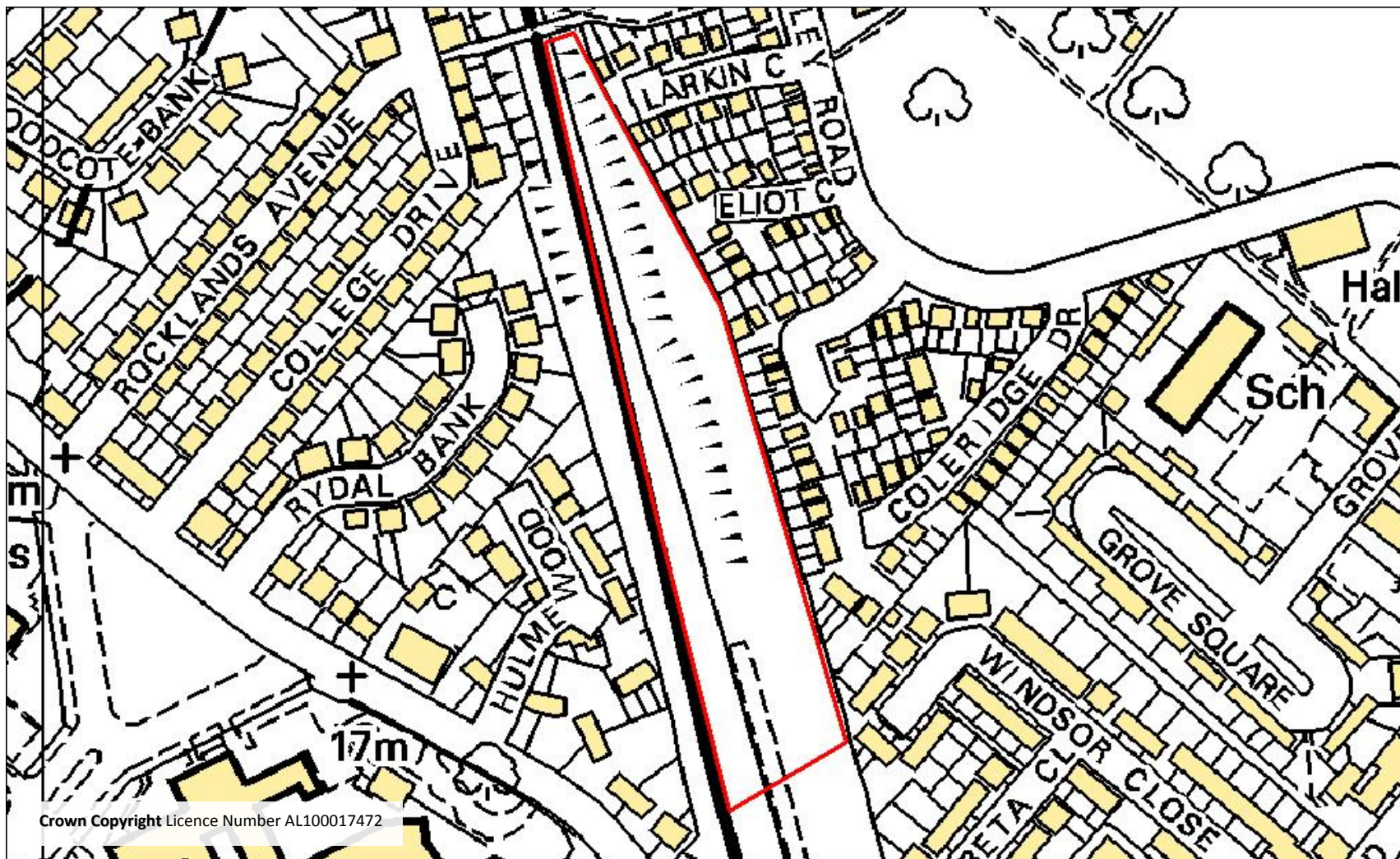


NEW FERRY BUTTERFLY PARK

Access: The Park is locked and is accessible on Sundays when wardened. May till August opening times normally 2-4pm, sometimes 12-4pm. To check opening times contact Paul Loughnane (0151 327 5923), other times accessible by arrangement. The Park is not open if the weather is very wet.

Location: The park lies off Howell Road, which lies off Bebington Road, adjacent to Bebington Station car park (O.S.Grid Ref: SJ 333852)



Habitat Summary

The park is an urban nature reserve developed on a former railway coal yard. There are acidic, calcareous, nutrient poor & rich grasslands reflecting the different industrial substrates of the past. In addition there are two ponds, hedgerows, scrub and hazel coppice.
