Access: Have you got your permit?

Location: Patrick's Wood lies in the south west corner of Brotherton Park, Bromborough, separated from the park by the River Dibbin. It is bounded on the western side by the Birkenhead-Chester railway line (O.S. Grid Ref.: SJ341825).



Habitat Summary

Part of an ancient woodland SSSI on the steep slopes above the River Dibbin, consisting mainly of oak, with a rich ground flora. A number of springs on the slope have formed small tributaries. The railway line is situated on a substantial embankment.
