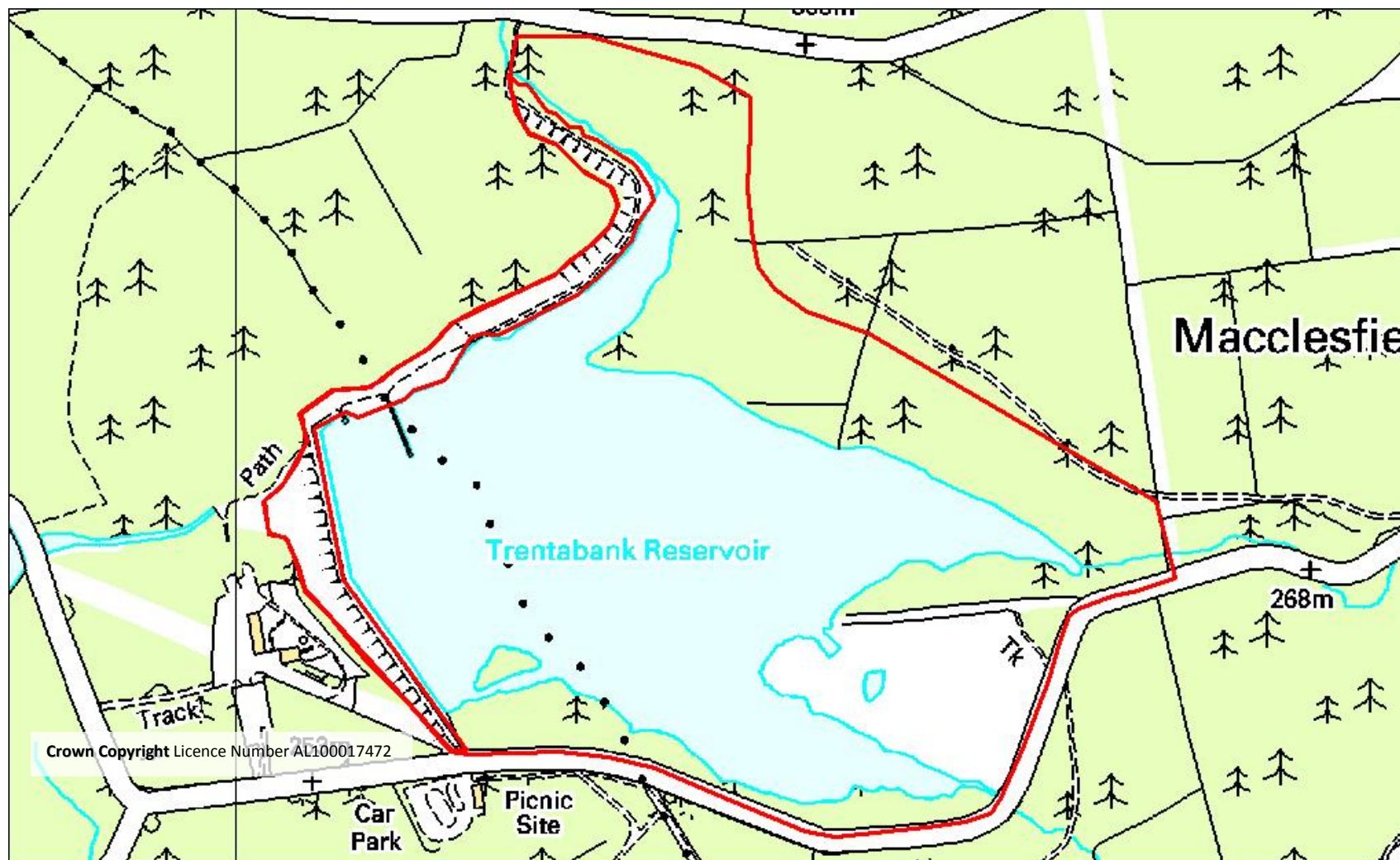


TRENTABANK RESERVIOR

Access: Have you got your permit?

Access to this site is restricted. Permits are required, these are obtainable from Cheshire Wildlife Trust; please email Jacki Hulse, Head of Estates & Land Management, on jhulse@cheshirewt.cix.co.uk to apply for one.

Location: The reservoir is in Macclesfield Forest, partly in the Peak District National Park, about 3 miles (5km) south east of Macclesfield (O.S. Grid Ref.: SJ962713).



Habitat Summary

Trentabank Nature Reserve (42.7 acres) lies within Macclesfield Forest at an elevation of approximately 800 feet. There is a coniferous plantation surrounding Trentabank reservoir with a large heronry of about 22 pairs.
